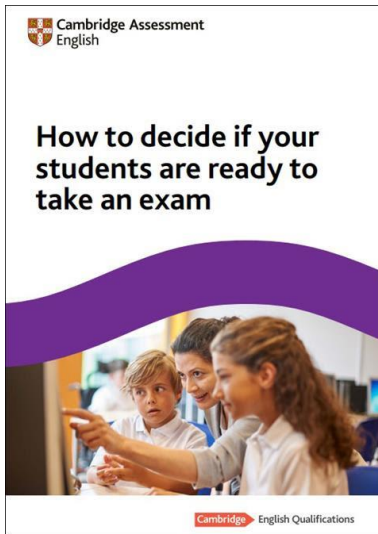

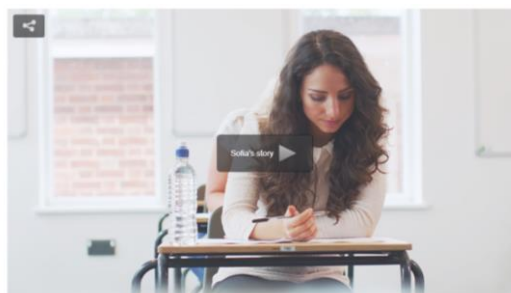

## Planning the School Year with Cambridge English



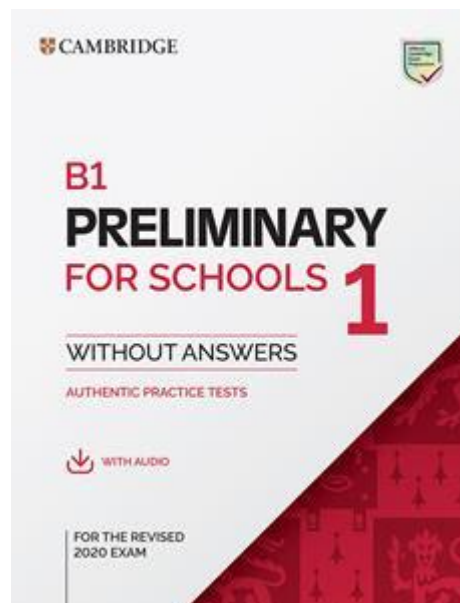
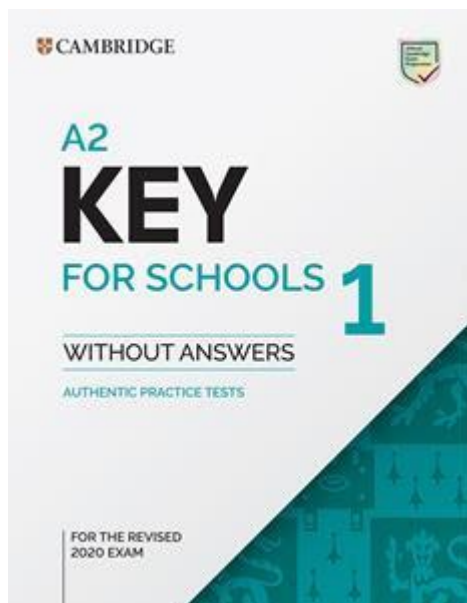
