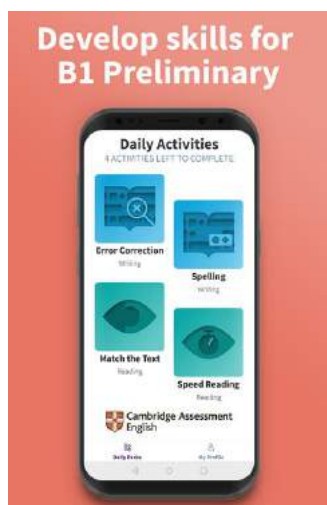

Improving English on the Go with a New App



In the October edition of **International Recognition** last year, we told you about “**Exam Lift**”, a brand new Cambridge Assessment English app to help candidates prepare for B1 Preliminary “on the go”. Last year the app had become available in Spain, Portugal, UK, Italy and Vietnam. Now, it has become available in the Americas too! **Exam Lift** has been launched to give students around the world a convenient way of practising and improving their English. It is a **free mobile app** aimed at students preparing for the [B1 Preliminary for Schools](#) exam.

Exam Lift includes skills-based activities that encourage students to practise their English in all four language skills – reading, writing, listening and speaking. As players complete the daily activities, they also get instant feedback on their performance.

Andrew Nye, Head of New Product Development at Cambridge Assessment English said: *‘We’ve designed **Exam Lift** so it encourages learning on the go for students preparing for the B1 Preliminary for Schools exam. It’s essential that students really enjoy their learning experience and that’s why the app has a series of daily skills-based activities that are really fun. **Exam Lift** is an engaging tool that complements what students are already doing in the classroom and it is a great way of increasing motivation.’*

[B1 Preliminary for Schools](#) is an English language qualification that is part of the range of Cambridge English Qualifications. The qualification shows that students have mastered the basics of English and have practical language skills for everyday use. It’s at level B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for languages.

A New Online Tool that Indicates Language Level



An online tool that gives students an instant indication of their English language level is now available as a widget for schools to embed on their websites. **Test your English** for websites from Cambridge Assessment English is ideal for language schools who want to engage more English language students on their websites. It

works by asking users 25 questions and then gives them an instant indication of their English language level. Schools who embed the test can customise the results page so that students get directed to relevant courses, exams and support materials depending on their levels.

'Finding out your English language level is one of the most common first steps for students starting out on their English language journey.' Said Emi Gibson, the Product Lead at Cambridge Assessment English. She continued: *'We've designed Test your English for websites so it gives students a really good starting point. The test is simple to set up for schools as it uses a widget approach, which means they just embed a snippet of code onto their website. Schools are encouraged to promote **Test your English** through their social media sites as it's a great way to drive traffic back to their websites.

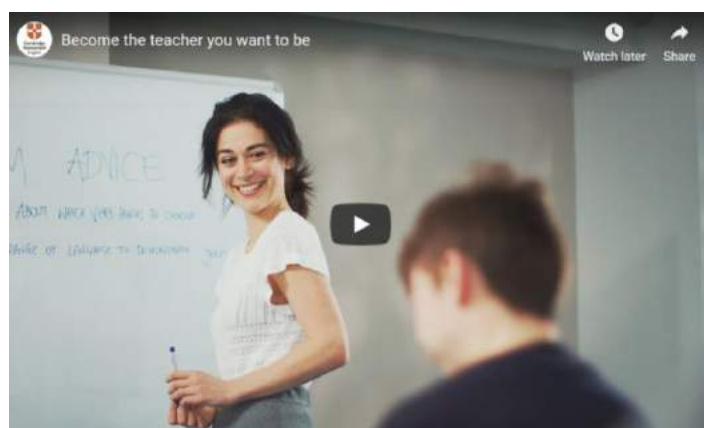
