### Preparation Centres Website and information about exam results

This is a reminder you can download your students' results, including your archived results using the <u>Online Results Service</u>.

To access the results, go to <a href="https://preparationcentres.cambridgeenglish.org/">https://preparationcentres.cambridgeenglish.org/</a> and log in using your preparation centre's normal log-in details. You will have access to your students' results and performance reports for your preparation centre.

The reports enable you to see how your students performed by skill, by grade, by Cambridge English Scale score and to compare performance by year and against national and global averages. The reports cover all Cambridge English Qualifications from Pre-A1 Starters to C2 Proficiency, including all Cambridge English Qualifications Business exams.







### Information for Candidates – helping you get your learners ready for their exam for Candidates – helping you get your learners ready for their exam

What should I bring? Is spelling important? How should I prepare? These may be questions you're familiar with if you help candidates prepare for exams. If you don't have all the answers, don't worry, help is at hand. The new *Information for Candidates* booklets are designed to give your learners all the information they need about their exam, but they are also a valuable teaching resource.

This blog post looks at four questions candidates often ask about their exam, with some helpful teaching ideas taken from these booklets.

#### What happens on exam day?

Knowing what to expect on exam day helps candidates to prepare and feel confident. Having a clear idea of what to bring and what happens when they step through the door helps candidates to focus on doing their best in their exam. The new *Information for Candidates* booklets have the answers to these questions.

**Tip!** In class, discuss exam-day routines. Share some of your own, for example getting lots of rest the night before, eating well, or the music you listen to. Ask learners to exchange ideas about what works for them, and what they expect to happen on the



day of the exam. Watch a candidate's <u>exam-day experience</u> and use the video to clarify anything learners are unsure of.

#### What's the exam like and how should I approach it?

Exam knowledge is an important part of any preparation course. It helps candidates manage their time and choose the best ways to approach tasks in each paper.

Make sure you're familiar with the exam. For example, the number of questions, the amount of time, how marks are awarded, the types of questions, texts, and the number of times each recording is heard. However, try not to give candidates too much information all at once as they might not remember it.

Give learners opportunities to discuss, share, and check what they know and can remember about each paper as they work towards the exam. This helps them feel confident, able to manage their time and concentrate on their answers when they open their paper on exam day.

As well as providing all this exam information, the *Information for Candidates* booklets have lots of clear, practical tips for each part of the exam. Encourage learners to try these tips, using them regularly during preparation.

**Tip!** After each practice activity, ask learners to think about what they did, and note:

- things to stop doing
- things to keep doing
- · things to start doing.

These can then be organised into personalised 'traffic light' checklists. Here's an example from the B2 First and B2 First for Schools Speaking paper:

**Things to stop doing** interrupt my speaking partner



Things to keep speak clearly

**doing** ask for the question to be repeated if I don't understand

show interest in what my partner is saying (eye contact,

Things to start doing

nodding)

Referring to checklists before practice activities reminds learners what to focus on. It's motivating to see the 'keep doing' category grow when they review their speaking performance. This is a useful individual activity, but why not encourage learners to give each other feedback on their speaking?

**Tip!** You can help develop learners' awareness of speaking strategies in the classroom. Firstly, 'model' the strategies, then ask learners to watch videos of candidates completing their Speaking exam on the <a href="Cambridge English YouTube channel">Cambridge English YouTube channel</a>. Ask them to identify examples of candidates using the speaking strategies you discussed in class.

#### How can I prepare for my exam?

Practice tests are an important part of exam preparation. They help candidates develop familiarity with the exam and give learners a chance to use the exam strategies they have practised in class. Doing practice tests against the clock allows learners to practise their timing so they feel prepared on exam day.

The best preparation is spending time developing their English language knowledge and skills. Language skills improve with practice. Learners need to use English, to speak, write, listen and read as much as possible. Help learners identify useful and enjoyable ways of using English outside the classroom with discussion that explores their interests and the language skills they most need to work on.

**Tip!** The 'Study tips' sections in each of the *Information for Candidates* booklets offer lots of ideas for developing English skills in the classroom and beyond. Here's a tip from the section on Reading and Use of English in the <u>B2 First for Schools</u> booklet. You can use it in class by asking your students to think of all the different types of text they read in their own language, discussing what they enjoy reading most. For homework,



ask them to find an article, book or blog, for example, in English on a topic they are interested in. Ask them to bring it to the next class, where they can talk about why they chose it and what they learned from it.

#### What happens next?

After the exam, encourage candidates to celebrate their success. This provides a sense of achievement. It's helpful for candidates to reflect on how they feel, what they can do now, and what the next step in their English language journey might be. They may be preparing for a higher-level exam, beginning a course of higher education, travelling, studying, working abroad or progressing in their career. The message is to keep learning.

### English improves people's lives, one story at a time

#### **Andreza from Brazil**

'I'd come so far on my English journey that I was now confident to express myself and I was no longer afraid of making mistakes.'

Andreza's first real conversation in English didn't happen until she was an adult. It was a telephone call with a university, which she remembers as a terrifying experience that she simply had to get through! It became the first step on her largely self-taught English learning journey that has seen her cement a career in Cambridge Assessment English's Madrid office where she uses English daily. Her English skills have gone from strength to strength and she says she draws inspiration from her love of classical ballet and the arts.

I was born in a small city near São Paulo, and I always wanted to learn English, but I never had the chance, as my parents couldn't afford classes. We did learn English in school, but it was a very basic level. After I finished school, I felt that communications and public relations were interesting career options for me as people always told me I was naturally expressive. I decided to go to college to study public relations in São Paulo, which was a big decision because I was the first person in my family to go to university and lots of friends couldn't choose this route at that time.



Once I arrived at university, one of my teachers told me I must have English in order to secure jobs in the PR industry. However, my big challenge was time, as I was balancing work and classes. I managed to find a few hours a week to study English myself which helped me improve, so I'm largely self-taught, but I was also lucky enough to get a place on an online government programme in Brazil, which helps students get the skills they need to study abroad.



I've been an amateur ballerina since I was 14 and my love of the arts is a great source of creativity, so I try to translate this into my work.

Interestingly I'd never had a real conversation in English until I was an adult, but that all changed one day. I was thinking of studying abroad, so I started applying for internships and I contacted the International Education University in Madrid, and a lady called me back to invite me to an event they were hosting. She spoke to me in English, and I was super nervous, but I got through it! It was then that I realised that I needed to get better at English!

I then moved to Madrid, and I was still not speaking very good English, so I tried to expose myself to English as much as I could. I started working in marketing agencies and both of them had a very multicultural team who were using way more English than I was used to. I had two American colleagues and one of them didn't speak Spanish, so we had to speak in English. She was very patient and helped me get over my fear of speaking in English which is a problem we have in Brazil – we might understand English, but we don't want to speak it. I was also asked to write adverts for marketing campaigns, plus content for blogs and social media. She gave me tips on how to express myself in a better way. I



also started writing in English and I had a colleague who was proofreading everything I was writing, which was a big help.

Eventually I decided to take a formal class and I studied for about three months in an English school in Madrid, but once again it was very hard. I couldn't enjoy classes because my level was very mixed. While I had become confident in expressing myself, I was having trouble with my grammar as I'd never properly studied it. One thing that really helped me was paying attention to how people speak, which words they use and in which context.

I then applied for a job at Cambridge Assessment English which was perfect for me because they wanted someone who spoke English, Spanish and Portuguese with a PR background. I got an interview where I had to present a marketing strategy for our online test Linguaskill, switching between Spanish and English multiple times which was a real challenge! I'd come so far on my English journey that I was now confident to express myself and I was no longer afraid of making mistakes. In my current role I do a lot of public relations work helping to write stories, building relationships with the media and organising events, and to do these I use English on a daily basis. We use English a lot in our day-to-day interaction as we're in close contact with teams in Cambridge, Italy and a lot of our centres who are more comfortable speaking in English.

In the communications industry you must be creative in order to face the challenges of your job. I've been an amateur ballerina since I was 14 and my love of the arts is a great source of creativity, so I try to translate this into my work. When people ask if it is a hobby, it's hard to say yes because it's more than a hobby. It's something that I've always connected with; it lets me think about things from another perspective and moves my heart. Also ballet is something you never stop learning, and I'd like to continue with my studies in this area. The advantage is that now I can access precious resources in English, lots of reading materials, films and other sources that weren't available to me before.



In the future I want to keep studying. I would like to take a Master's, something more academically focused. I don't want to study anything related to PR and communications — and I'd like to combine something else with PR.

It will let me use another part of the brain and get a different perspective. Let's see what I find!




