These courses have been a wonderful opportunity to learn, reflect and share experiences together. At the same time,



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Anglo is preparing to administer **TKT Digital**, and we hope this new format will encourage many more teachers to embark on their own professional development journey.

You will also find information about the new **C2 Proficiency Trainer**, with six practice tests, expert guidance and targeted preparation for candidates working towards Cambridge's highest-level English qualification.

Finally, we turn our attention to something that is central to everything we do: **the candidate experience**. We introduce the Candidate Journey that will accompany candidates from enrolment and registration through to their Confirmation of Entry, exam day and results.

And this is particularly relevant now: **enrolments for our November and December Cambridge examination sessions are already open**, with the Early Fee Discount for paper-based examinations available until **30 September**.

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Global Preparation Centre Even 2026: Connecting Teachers Around the World



On 14 and 15 October 2026, teachers and educational institutions from around the world will have the opportunity to come together for a new edition of the Cambridge Global Preparation Centre Event, an annual virtual event broadcast live from Cambridge.

Designed especially for teachers and institutions preparing learners for Cambridge English Qualifications, the event aims to provide practical support, professional development and inspiration to help teachers feel more confident when preparing their students for their Cambridge English journey.

The event will be repeated across two days to accommodate teachers in different time zones, making this a truly global professional development experience.

For participants in Argentina, Chile, Paraguay and Uruguay, the recommended session will take place on Wednesday, 14 October, from 13:00 to 16:45.

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Cambridge Young Learners Digital Highly Commended at the 2026 International e-Assessment Awards

Cambridge English Qualifications Digital for young learners have received international recognition at the 2026 International e-Assessment Awards, where **Pre A1 Starters Digital** and **A1 Movers Digital** were highly commended in two categories: **Most Innovative Use of Technology** and **Best School Digital Assessment Programme/Implementation**.

The recognition highlights something particularly important in assessment today: digitalisation is not simply about transferring a traditional test from paper to a screen. It is about using technology to create an assessment experience that is appropriate for the learners taking it.

In the **Best School Digital Assessment Programme/Implementation** category, the judges highlighted the qualifications' strong focus on **learner experience, accessibility and thoughtful design**. Particular recognition was given to the creation of an assessment environment that is supportive, interactive and appropriate for the age of the candidates.

In the **Most Innovative Use of Technology** category, the judging panel praised Cambridge's use of technology to create an assessment experience that feels **natural, interactive, imaginative and enjoyable** for young learners.

A digital experience designed for children

Launched in **February 2025**, Cambridge English Qualifications Digital for young learners were developed specifically around the needs and experiences of children.

From the beginning of the test, candidates enter an environment designed to engage them. Each child creates and personalises an **avatar**, which can then be customised with rewards earned



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after completing tasks. Candidates progress through imaginative settings, including underwater and dinosaur-themed islands, turning the assessment into an English-language journey.

These features are much more than decorative additions. They are intended to encourage a positive attitude towards both **learning and assessment**, helping children see their progress and experience a sense of achievement as they move through the test.

As **Francesca Woodward, Global Managing Director for English at Cambridge University Press & Assessment**, explained, the aim when developing the digital qualifications was to create an experience that reflected young candidates' everyday lives while helping them build confidence and perform at their best.

Research behind the innovation

Behind the engaging interface lies an extensive programme of research and development.

Pre A1 Starters Digital and A1 Movers Digital were developed following consultation and research involving **parents, learners, teachers and exam centres around the world**. The development process included pre-testing with **3,500 candidates in 90 examination centres across 28 countries**.

This research-informed approach has been central to ensuring that the digital experience is not only engaging but also **motivating and fair**, while continuing to provide young learners with a solid foundation for their future English-language development.

Assessment as a positive part of learning

Perhaps the most significant aspect of this international recognition is the philosophy behind the qualifications.



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For young children, an examination can be one of their first experiences of formal assessment. Making that experience positive, age-appropriate and motivating can therefore have an impact that goes well beyond the result itself.

Cambridge English Qualifications Digital for young learners demonstrate how technology can be used not simply to modernise assessment, but to **rethink the learner experience** — reducing unnecessary barriers, increasing engagement and allowing children to demonstrate what they can do in an environment created with them in mind.

Looking ahead to 30 years of Young Learners

The recognition comes at a particularly significant moment in the history of Cambridge English Young Learners examinations. **Looking ahead, the team at Cambridge is preparing to celebrate three decades of young learner exams in 2027**, while continuing to expand its portfolio of digital qualifications.

The upcoming launch of **A2 Flyers Digital in 2027** will complete the full suite of **Cambridge English Qualifications Digital for young learners**, marking another important milestone in the evolution of an assessment journey that has been supporting children around the world for almost three decades.

For **Anglo**, this anniversary has a special significance. Our own journey with Cambridge Young Learners began on **19 October 1996, when we launched Pre A1 Starters in Uruguay**. Since then, generations of young learners have taken their first steps along the Cambridge English Qualifications pathway through these examinations.

From those first Starters examinations in 1996 to today's engaging digital experience, the format may have evolved enormously, but the fundamental purpose remains the same: **to give children a positive first experience of international assessment, recognise what they can do in English and motivate them to continue learning.**

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New C2 Proficiency Trainer!

Six practice tests, expert guidance and targeted preparation for C2 Proficiency



Preparing for **C2 Proficiency**, Cambridge's highest-level English qualification, requires much more than simply completing practice tests. At this level, candidates need to understand the demands of each task, refine their exam technique and develop the precision, flexibility and sophistication expected of a highly proficient user of English.

The new **C2 Proficiency Trainer**, published by Cambridge University Press & Assessment in **July 2026**, has been designed with exactly this in mind. Part of Cambridge's well-established **Trainer** series, the new title combines **six full practice tests with expert guidance, exam strategies and targeted practice**, helping candidates become familiar with the examination while developing the techniques they need to perform at their best.

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TKT goes Digital: Learning and Growing Together

This year Will bring an exciting new development for the Teaching Knowledge Test (TKT), with the introduction of TKT Digital, offering a new way for teachers to gain this internationally recognised Cambridge qualification.

At Anglo, we are delighted to be accompanying groups of teachers on their own TKT journey — and it has been a particularly rewarding experience.

On 28th August marked an important milestone, as one of our groups supported by AUDEPPI sat the paper-based version of TKT Module 1, following several months of preparation together. Meanwhile, a second group is currently working towards TKT: Young Learners and will also sit the paper-based examination on 6 November.

At the same time, we are already getting ready to administer TKT Digital at Anglo, and we are very excited about the possibilities this new format will bring.

Much more than preparing for an exam

Preparing teachers to take their TKT examination is much more than exam preparation.

It is an opportunity to discuss teaching, revisit important methodological principles, analyse classroom situations and, most importantly, share experiences.

TKT provides an excellent framework for these conversations. It gives teachers a common language to talk about teaching and learning and encourages them to reflect on why we make certain choices in the classroom.

For the Module 1 group, this has meant exploring areas such as language and background to language learning and teaching. For our Young Learners group, the focus is on understanding the particular characteristics and needs of younger learners and considering how these should influence the way we teach, manage and assess them.



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And next: TKT Digital

Anglo is currently preparing to administer the digital version of TKT, and we are very much looking forward to adding this new format to the opportunities available to teachers.

Digital delivery represents an important evolution for TKT, making it possible to combine the established value and international recognition of the qualification with the advantages of digital assessment.

Most importantly, we hope that this new format will encourage many more teachers to embark on their own TKT journey.

Investing in teachers

Qualifications such as TKT are valuable because they recognise professional knowledge, but their impact goes far beyond the certificate itself.

Professional development gives us an opportunity to reflect, question our practice, revisit what we know and continue learning from one another. Ultimately, investing in teachers is also an investment in their learners and in the quality of the educational experiences we provide.

We are extremely happy with how these courses have developed and very grateful to all the teachers who have made the experience so enjoyable.

To our Module 1 teachers: congratulations on reaching this important milestone today!

To our TKT Young Learners teachers: we look forward to continuing the journey together towards 6 November.

And as Anglo prepares for TKT Digital, we very much hope that many more teachers will join us!
